

## 2008 UCSB Junior Lifeguard Scholarship information & Application



UCSB Jr Lifeguards provided 31 full and partial scholarships to local underserved and at-risk children in 2007. Scholarships are granted on a “first come first served” basis until available spaces are filled. Information provided in this application is kept strictly confidential. We wish to thank the SANTA BARBARA FOUNDATION and the ORFALEA FOUNDATION for their generous support.

Junior Lifeguard "Full Scholarship" candidates are asked to contact the Santa Barbara Police Activities League at 962-5560. All swim lesson scholarship candidates are to contact us directly (see top of the page).

Junior Lifeguard Partial Scholarship candidates may apply directly to UCSB by phone (893 7616 x 3) or by mail (see top) after April 1st. Page 2 of this document is a UCSB partial scholarship application.

New Junior Lifeguard candidates must pass a swim test. Free swim lessons to help candidates pass this test are held on the dates listed in the Calendar (posted to the UCSB Junior Lifeguard website address above).

Scholarship eligibility is equivalent to the candidate qualifying under one of:

- Free or Reduced Cost School Breakfast, Lunch or Milk Program
- Food Stamp program
- Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC)
- Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)
- Applicant is a ward of the court or of a County welfare agency (Foster care)

A candidate may also qualify by living in a household with income at or below that required to qualify for one of the above programs. A “Household” is a group of individuals who are living as one economic unit and share living expenses. “Income” means any of the following:

- Earnings from wages, salaries, tips, strike benefits, income from own business;
- Unemployment Compensation, Workers Compensation;
- Public Assistance Payments, Alimony and Child Support Payments;
- Pensions, Supplemental Security Income, Retirement Payments, Social Security;
- Disability Benefits, Interest, Dividends, Investments, Trusts, Regular contributions from persons not living in the household, Royalties, etc.
